- **Collaborative partnership** aimed at improving older peoples' lives, helping them to contribute to society, and reduce pressure on health and care systems.



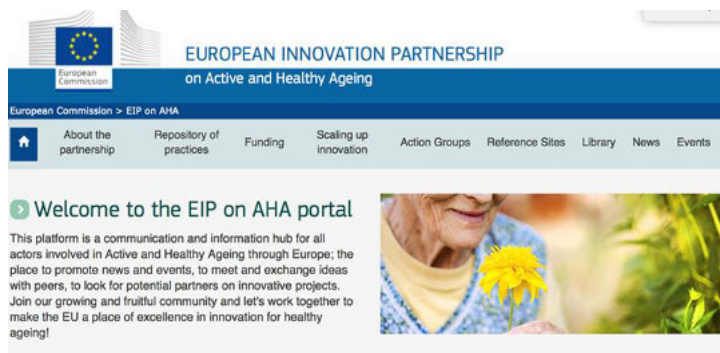
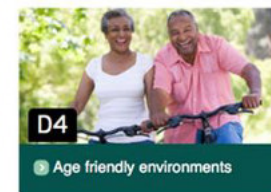

Procurement Directive

Directive 2014/24/EU on public procurement and repealing Directive 2004/18/EC

- **Until 2016:** When possible, the specifications **SHOULD** be decided taking accessibility criteria for persons with disabilities in account.
- **From 2017:** When the procured is going to be used by humans, the technical specifications **SHALL** be decided taking all users needs into account, including persons with disabilities.



Web accessibility directive

Directive 2016/2102/EU on the accessibility of the websites and mobile applications of public sector bodies

- EN 301 549 (minimum): Accessibility requirements suitable for public procurement of ICT products and services in Europe”
- Website
- Intranet
- Extranet
- Documents
- Apps
- Disproportionate burden



Web accessibility directive

- Public sector
- Serving the general interest
- MS: training, monitoring...
- Out of scope: broadcasting, NGOs, private sector



How will this happen?

- National implementation
- National monitoring
- European Commission decides on the method
- Accessibility statement
- Complaints mechanism



Directive transposition

- WADEX: EC, MS representatives + 7 experts
- EU level: monitoring, accessibility statement
- National level: legislation adaptation, implementation by PA



Stepwise entering into force

- Sept 23, 2018: adoption
- Sept 23, 2019: new
- Sept 23, 2020: existing
- June 23, 2021: apps
